CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE

of Prineville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of one well

a tributary of Rager Creek (Beaver Creek) for the purpose of domestic use at Rager Ranger Station and fire protection

under Permit No. G-1943 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon: that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 13, 1961 for 0.11 c.f.s.
August 18, 1961 for 0.02 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33, T. 15 S., R. 25 E., W. M. Well located: 688 feet South and 513 feet East from NW Corner, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
