## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That

CASCADE RANCHES, INC.

of Lake Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East and West Forks of Lake Creek and supplemental storage under Appl. No. \* a tributary of Lake Creek (Little Butte Creek) for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 266.0 acres under Permit No. 26652 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters

under Permit No. 26652 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.30 cubic feet per second, being 1.65 c.f.s. from each Fork and 310 acre feet of supplemental storage from Woodrat Knob Reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_{\overline{k}}^{1}$   $SW_{\overline{k}}^{1}$ , Section 5;  $NW_{\overline{k}}^{1}$   $SE_{\overline{k}}^{1}$ , Section 6; T. 37 S., R. 2 E., W. M.  $NE_{\overline{k}}^{1}$   $NE_{\overline{k}}^{1}$ , Section 36, T. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage under Permit No. R-2337 in Woodrat Knob Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1839; provided further that the right to the use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. at Raygold, more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam, and \*\*\*

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
