CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ORAL W. TUCKER

of 1381 Spring Street, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hog Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of barn and corral cleaning and stock

under Permit No. 31560 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 4, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for stock and 0.01 c.f.s. for barn and corral cleaning

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 21, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion point located 90 feet North and 1450 feet West from Center, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 20
Barn and Corral cleaning and Stock SW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 21
T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
