CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, FOREST SERVICE, State of Oregon, has made proof of Prineville, to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Jordan Spring, Rimrock Spring

a tributary of Willow Creek for the purpose of stock and domestic

under Permit No. 27531 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 9, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Jordan Spring for stock use and 0.01 c.f.s. from Rimrock Spring for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 34, T. 12 S., R. 14 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located: Jordan Spring - 742 feet North and 2953 feet West; Rimrock Spring - 20 feet South and 3795 feet West; Both from NE Corner, Section 34.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
