, has made proof of Route 2, Box 85 E, Silverton , State of Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Abiqua Creek

a tributary of Pudding River sand and gravel washing

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32842 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 16, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL SEL, Section 22, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1750 feet North and 780 feet West from SE Corner,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _ _ _ _ _ _ of one cubic foot per second

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Section 22 T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This right is subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
