or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL NWL, as projected within Mascher DLC, Section 10, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Spring located 660 feet South and 80 feet West from NL Corner. Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,
