CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT L. JANZEN

of Route 2, Box 69, Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of four wells

a tributary of Palmer Creek (Yamhill River) for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 112.72 acres

under Permit No. G-2901 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 11, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.41 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$, $NE\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$, both as projected within Kirkwood DLC 64, Section 29, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Wells located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.9 acres	$SW\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Sawyer DLC 59
39.9 acres	$SE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Sawyer DLC 59
0.3 acre	$SW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Odell DLC 49
2.9 acres	$SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Odell DLC 49
15.4 acres	$SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Kirkwood DLC 64
18.5 acres	$NE\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Kirkwood DLC 64
17.2 acres	$NW\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Kirkwood DLC 64
2.62 acres	$NE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Sawyer DLC 59

Wells located: No. 1, 1260 feet North and 20 feet East; No. 2, 220 feet South and 720 feet East; No. 3, 260 feet North and 5 feet East; No. 4, 660 feet South and 235 feet West; all from the N reentrant Corner, Kirkwood DLC 64.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
