CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONALD F. and JOYCE L. HEIN

of 2304 White Lantern Lane, Orange, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Chehalem Creek for the purpose of orchard spraying and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 26561 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 26, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second for spraying and 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 27, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Spring located 1050 feet North and 550 feet West from the NE Corner, Conger DLC 52.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Orchard spraying SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Orchard spraying Lot 7 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
Orchard spraying Lot 8 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
Orchard spraying Lot 6 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4)
Section 27
T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Subject to terms and conditions of Decree of the Circuit Court for Yamhill County entered October 12, 1964.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
