CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HOMER H. RAMBO

of Ontario, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 77.0 acres

under Permit No. 2807 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 7, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 18 S., R. 47 E., W. M. Diversion point located 1570 feet South and 1085 feet East from Center of Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

25.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
11.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Certificate of water right issued to Homer H. Rambo and recorded at page 3210, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 99.7 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 62.7 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer entered April 16, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Homer H. Rambo.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
