CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That F. S. McCULLOUGH

, State of of Post Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Drake Creek, Keeney Creek, Miller Lake, Keeney Creek Reservoir, Frank Reservoir, and Peterson Reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-31800, Permit No. R-2067 a tributary of Crooked River irrigation of 22.3 acres and supplemental irrigation of 40.0 acres

under Permit No. 25064 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 21, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second; Water to be diverted from Keeney Creek when available and any deficiency in the available supply in Keeney Creek is to be made up by diversion from Drake Creek.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Keeney Creek - NWL SEL, Section 2; Peterson Reservoir - NEL SEL; Frank Reservoir - SEL SEL; Section 15; Keeney Reservoir - SEL NEL, Drake Creek - SWL SWL, Section 22; Miller Lake - NWL SWL, Section 23; T. 17 S., * The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow for lands described as primary and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under permit No. R-2067, provided further that the use of the waters of Keeney Creek and Miller Lake as allowed herein shall be limited to the lands described as primary;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
