CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That H. A. BRATTAIN, P. J. BRATTAIN AND Mrs. C. N. BRATTAIN-SMALL of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Dairy and Auger Creeks, tributary of Chewaucan River for the purpose of the irrigation of 100 acres of land, and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: (3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year)

15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 30 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Two and 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section One, Township Thirty-six South, Range Seventeen: 15 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-five, Township Thirty-five South, Range Seventeen, All East of Willamette Meridian in Lake County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
