of Room 212, Williams Building, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lenz Creek

a tributary of Big Springs Creek (Williamson River) irrigation of 101.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 29539 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 2, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.27 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NWL, Section 35, T. 30 S., R. 8 E., W. M. Diversion point located North 48° 54L°, West 4377.7 feet from SE Corner, Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

36.3 acres NET NWT
0.5 acre NWT NWT
26.6 acres SET NWT
18.8 acres NET SWT
19.3 acres Lot 2 (SET SWT)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
