Paisley , State of	Oregon		has a right to the use of

the waters of Fuller Creek, a tributary of Chewaucan River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 130.9 acres of land and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume

5, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforcsaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said accree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year)

19 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 0.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Sixteen: 5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 4 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 20 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 38 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 12 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 1 acre in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 0.4 acres in the Southeast quarter of South

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lanus or place of use herein described.
