CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **COMMERCIAL SAND and GRAVEL SUPPLY COMPANY**

of **P. O. Box 188, Salem**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Willamette River**

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of **washing sand and gravel**

under Permit No. **28996** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 18, 1963**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.11 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 30, T. 7 S., R. 3 W., W. M.** Diversion point located **1690 feet North and 750 feet West from the SW Corner, N¹/₂ NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 31, T. 8 S., R. 3 W., W. M.** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **-----** of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 30
T. 7 S., R. 3 W., W. M.**

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
