CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **KENNETH L. OGREN**

of 10470 Sunnyview Rd. NE, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-44068, Permit No. R-4989 a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 74.7 acres

under Permit No. 32482 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 15, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second from unnamed stream and 3.0 acre feet from reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Dunbar DLC 48, Section 30, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1100 feet North and 10 feet East from SW Corner, Dunbar DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4989,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
22.1 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.6 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
all as projected within Dunbar DLC 48

0.4 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
26.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
15.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
all as projected within Dunbar DLC 48
Section 30
T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
