CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CARL A. SCHMID**

of Route 3, Box 167, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-2708

a tributary of Drift Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 16.9 acres

under Permit No. 32512 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 11, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion point located 200 feet South and 790 feet West from NE Corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.1 acre Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 8
T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
