CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK L. SHAW

of Sisters, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of irrigation of 48 2/3 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1883;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.97 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
 12.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
 1 2/3 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4

Certificate of water right issued to Frank L. Shaw and recorded at page 429, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 70.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 21 1/3 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered May 3, 1966. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Frank L. Shaw.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
