CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PETE F. LEITHAUSER

of Sisters, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of
irrigation of 21 1/3 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 120; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1883;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

21 1/3 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 4
T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an
order of the State Engineer entered May 3, 1966 pursuant to the provisions of
ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and together with the certificate recorded at page
36136, Volume 28, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to
Frank L. Shaw and recorded at page 429, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right
Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
