CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SOUTH SIDE DITCH COMPANY
and WILLIAM G. BARE

of Glendale, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek

a tributary of Azalea River (South Fork Umpqua River) for the purpose of irrigation of 127.0 acres

under Permit No. 7497 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 20, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.59 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20; T. 32 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion points located: South 80° West 1164.1 feet from E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 21 and 270 feet North and 20 feet West from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 20. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
