## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILLIAM G. BARE

of Glendale , State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 12.2 acres for the purpose of

under Permit No. 22624 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 10, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SWL, Section 20, T. 32 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located 270 feet North and 20 feet West from SL Corner, Section 20. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.4 acres NEL NWL 9.6 acres NWL NWL 0.2 acre SEL NWL Section 29 T. 32 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 22, 1965, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Dan F. Clare and recorded at page 26228, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
