## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1860

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre in any irrigation season

The point of diversion is located in the  $NW_{4}^{1}$   $SE_{4}^{1}$ , Section 19, T. 1 N., R. 14 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre NW SEL 0.2 acre SW NE Section 19 T. 1 N., R. 14 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to James C. Benson and recorded at page 5602, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 13.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the use of water appurtenant to 1.0 acre was transferred and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 12.0 acres was cancelled by orders of the State Engineer entered June 20, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation as provided by an order of the State Engineer entered June 30, 1969, and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to James C. Benson.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
