CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED N. NODINE

of Cambridge, State of Idaho, has a right
to the use of the waters of Catherine Creek, Nodine Slough

a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of
irrigation of 3.5 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three acre feet per
acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth
of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

3.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 19
T. 4 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Fred N. Nodine and recorded at page 6491,
Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the
use of water for irrigation of 6.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion
for the irrigation of 2.5 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer
entered May 16, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right
to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore
issued to Fred N. Nodine.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
