CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Route 1, Box 110, Riddle , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mitchell Creek

a tributary of Cow Creek irrigation of 2.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32311 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 12, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWL NWL, as projected within Tiller DLC 63, Section 30, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion points located: 20 feet South and 250 feet East, 350 feet South and 240 feet East; Both from NW Corner, DLC 63. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres SWL NWL as projected within Tiller DLC 63
Section 30
T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
