## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN W. VANDERBILT, M. D. and VERNON J. COURTNEY

of Route 1, Box 273, La Grande , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and unnamed spring

a tributary of Grande Ronde River drainage irrigation of 5.0 acres and stock use

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27646 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 26. 1961** 

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second; being 0.11 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and 0.02 c.f.s. from unnamed spring and being 0.12 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SWL NEL, SEL NEL, Section 5, T. 2 S., R. 38 E.,

W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow in the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3330;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 5.0 acres SW1 NE1 Section 4
T. 2 S., R. 38 E., W. M.

Diversion points located: Stream - 660 feet South and 5420 feet West; Spring - 770 feet South and 4460 feet West; both from NE Corner, SW NET, Section 4.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
