CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JOAN DUCKETT, ADMINISTRATRIX OF BOUVÉE ESTATE**
BY ROY WELLS, LESSEE

of **Alicel**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **State Ditch of Grande Ronde River**

a tributary of **Snake River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 258.2 acres**

under Permit No. **28727** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 1, 1963**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **5.06 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 15, T. 2 S., R. 39 E., W. M.** Diversion points located: **30 feet South and 2410 feet West; 2640 feet South, and 2230 feet West; both from NE¹/₄ Corner, Section 15.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than **300 c.f.s.** at USGS Gage No. **3325** and more than **420 c.f.s.** at Oregon-Washington border,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 29.2 acres SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄
- 39.9 acres SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄
- Section 10

- 37.2 acres NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄
- 29.6 acres NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄
- 25.0 acres SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄
- 34.7 acres SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄
- 37.2 acres NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄
- 25.4 acres NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄
- Section 15
- T. 2 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
