CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Alicel , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of State Ditch of Grande Ronde River

a tributary of Snake River irrigation of 258.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28727 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

April 1. 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.06 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NWL, NWL SWL, Section 15, T. 2 S., R. 39 E., W. M. Diversion points located: 30 feet South and 2410 feet West; 2640 feet South and 2230 feet West; both from Nr Corner, Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a property of the cone cybic foot per second.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 c.f.s. at Oregon-Washington border,

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
