CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That S. P. DICKS

of Lakeview, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Mill Creek, a tributary of Crooked Creek, Loveless Creek, Crooked Creek and Dairy Creeks, tributaries of Chewaucan River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 523.25 acres of land, domestic and stock use under proofs No. 50, 51 and 52 and irrigation and stock use under proof No. 53

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875 as to lands under proofs No. 50, 51 and 52 and 1882 as to lands under proof No. 53.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations, contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(Proof No. 50 - 47½ acres irrigated from Mill Creek, a tributary of Crooked Creek) 11.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 14.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section One: 4.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Two: 15.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 0.25 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Eleven, Township Thirty-seven South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 51: 65.5 acres of land irrigated from Loveless Creek) 10.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section One; 21 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 26 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 8 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twelve, Township Thirty-seven South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 52 - 235½ acres of land irrigated from Crooked Creek) 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 24 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 12 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eleven: 17 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 39.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 17 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 25 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 35 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 1 acre in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 15 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twelve, Township Thirty-seven South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

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(Proof No. 53 - 175 acres of land irrigated from Dairy Creek) 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Two; 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 25 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 20 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section One, Township Thirty-six South, Range Seventeen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

All of above land shall be limited to 3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
