the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake, and Elder Creek, a tributary of Chewaucan River

for the purpose of

the irrigation of 445 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1878 as to kands under proofs
No. 54 and 55 and 1897 as to lands under proof

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth in connection with each tract described below; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Proof No. 54 from Chewancan River. 4.8 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year)
40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty, Township Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen East of Willamette Meridian in Lake County, Oregon.

(4.4 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season. being the period from April 1 to September 15th of each year) 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 32.5 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 32.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Thirty, Township Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 55 from Chewaucan River, 4.4 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year) 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty: 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine, Township Thirty-three South, Range Nineteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

(Proof No. 56 from Elder Creek. 3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year) 30 acres in the Scuthwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 15 acres in the Southeast cuarter of Northwest quarter; 15 acres in the Northwest quarter; 20 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 20 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast q arter of Section Thirty-One, Township Thirty-five South, Range Eighteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
