CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That J. B. ELDER

of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Crooked Creek, a tributary of Chewaucan River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 291.5 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1873

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion
of 1/25 cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth
below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

(3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from
April 1 to September 15 of each year) 29.5 acres in the Northwest quarter of
Northeast quarter and 10 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter;
33.5 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 16.5 acres in the
Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 8.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of
Southeast quarter; 14 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter and
29 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-five,
Township Thirty-five South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake
County, Oregon.

Also the remaining tracts in the South half of Southeast quarter of
Section Thirty-one, Township Thirty-five South, Range Twenty-one East of
Willamette Meridian, and the remaining tracts in the East half of Section Thirty-
six, Township Thirty-five South, Range Twenty East of Willamette Meridian, con-
taining 150 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
