## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES M. HAYES

of Route 2, Box 262 H, Dallas , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rickreall Creek

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of domestic use of one family, including irrigation of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre lawn and garden

under Permit No. 30293 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8. 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NEL, Section 36, T. 7 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion point located 35 feet South and 15 feet East from the NE Corner, Lot 15, Leuterman's LaCreole Summer Home Tracts.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any caner

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any ciner right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows: Lot 14, Lauterman's LaCreole Summer Home Tracts.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
