CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That . . . JASON S. ELDER

of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake
for the purpose of the irrigation of 1 acre of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from June 14, 1908

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
(3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year) Beginning at the Southwest corner of the intersection of West and Willow Streets, Paisley, Oregon; thence South 200'; thence West 50'; thence South 100'; thence West 75'; thence North 300'; thence East 125' to place of beginning.

Beginning at a point on the West line of Willow Street 200' South from the Southwest intersection of Willow and West streets, Paisley, Oregon; thence Westerly 50'; thence Southerly 100'; thence Easterly 50'; thence Northerly 100' to place of beginning. All lines to be parallel to the streets of Paisley, Oregon. All in Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-three South, Range Eighteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
