CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ELDON and VIRGINIA KENT

of Route 1, Box 45, Bonanza, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Noble Reservoir No. 1 constructed under Appl. No. R-28975, Permit No. R-2306

a tributary of Miller Creek (Lost River) for the purpose of irrigation of 99.0 acres

under Permit No. 26482 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 29, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 145.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 32, T. 39 S., R. 13 E., W. M. Diversion point located 4810 feet East and 4350 feet North from SW Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of 3 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 145.0 acre feet per year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 12.2 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
 - 1.1 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
 - 28.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
 - 24.4 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
 - 33.3 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4
- Section 32
T. 39 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

Diversion from Noble Creek to Reservoir located 6920 feet North and 1650 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 32, T. 39 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
