CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ESTATE OF MARTHA J. FARROW, deceased
of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake
for the purpose of the irrigation of 23.58 acres of land, and domestic and stock use
under Proof No. 71 and irrigation under proof No. 70
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885 as to lands under proof
No. 70 and 1901 as to lands under proof No. 71

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth in connection with each tract described below, and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
Proof No. 70 - 0.05 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter, and 0.50 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-three South, Range Eighteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

Proof No. 71 - 13.3 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-three South, Range Eighteen East of Willamette Meridian, in Lake County, Oregon.

All of the above described lands shall be limited to 3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
