CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That MARY C. GREEN

of Watsonville, State of California has a right to the use of
the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake
for the purpose of the irrigation of $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of $\frac{1}{25}$ of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: (3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.) Lots 8 and 9, Block F, Second Addition to the Town of Paisley, Oregon; and a piece beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 8, Block F, said Second Addition; thence North 150'; thence East 100'; thence South 150'; thence West 100' to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
