CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BOISE CASCADE CORPORATION

of P. O. Box 200, Boise, State of Idaho, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Well No. 3

a tributary of Willamette River (Columbia River) for the purpose of Industrial use in plywood plant, stud mill and mill pond

under Permit No. G-2884 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 22, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Cook DLC 63, Section 21, T. 8 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Well located 630 feet South and 2546 feet East from the NW Corner, DLC 63.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Burbank DLC 43
NW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Burbank DLC 43
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Burbank DLC 43
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Cook DLC 63
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Cook DLC 63
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Burbank DLC 43
Section 21
T. 8 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
