CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That . . . J. L. HAMPTON and SADIE L. HAMPTON

of Paisley , State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake

for the purpose of the irrigation of 3/4 of an acre of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1899

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: (3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year) Lots 7, 8 and 9, East Addition to the Town of Paisley, Oregon; also, commencing at a point 150' North from the Southeast corner of Block E, of East Addition aforesaid; thence North along East boundary of said Block E, 150' to Northeast corner of said block; thence at right angles East 100'; thence at right angles South and parallel with East line of said Block E, 150'; thence at right angles and West 100' to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
