CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LOW LINE DITCH COMPANY

of Prineville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of irrigation of 216.0 acres, domestic and stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use, and 2.70 cubic feet per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, T. 14 S., R. 14 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Low Line Ditch Company and recorded at page 608, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for stock and domestic use and for the irrigation of 230.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 14 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered August 6, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for stock and domestic use and for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Low Line Ditch Company.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
