CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **NEWTON ROBERTSON**

of Monument , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of irrigation of 22.0 acres

under Permit No. 3638 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 9, 1917;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 9 S., R. 28 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

22.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12
T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Newton Robertson and recorded at page 4783, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 62.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 40.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered August 15, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Newton Robertson.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
