## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. C. WARD

of Talent, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Wagner Creek

a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 4.9 acres, domestic and stock use  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1861;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per  
second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

4.9 acres of the following described premises: Beginning at the SE  
Corner, Section 2, T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W. M., thence West 13 chains;  
South 20 chains; West 7 chains; North 15 chains; East 5 chains to  
Wagner Creek; thence along creek northwesterly to where it intersects  
South line of D. L. C. No. 37, said T. and R., thence East 2.25 chains;  
North 14.75 chains; East 25 chains; South 20 chains, to place of begin-  
ning, containing 65 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres of land.

Certificate of water right issued to J. C. Ward and recorded at page 16061,  
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the  
use of water for domestic and stock use and for the irrigation of 8.0 acres.  
Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 3.1 acres was changed  
by order of the State Engineer entered August 22, 1969. This certificate is  
issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for domestic and stock  
use and for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. C.  
Ward.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
