CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That THOMAS A. and HERBERT L. CARLTON

of Prospect, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 38.2 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.76 cubic feet per second

The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, T. 33 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.3 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
28.2 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 23

7.7 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 24
T. 33 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Thomas A. and Herbert L. Carlton and recorded at page 32721, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 62.5 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 24.3 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered August 6, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supercedes the certificate heretofore issued to Thomas A. and Herbert L. Carlton.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
