CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. C. BABCOCK

of Box 151, Cave Junction, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of Illinois River (Rogue River) for the purpose of irrigation of 9.8 acres

under Permit No. 4449 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 3.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 2
 T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to C. C. Babcock and recorded at page 12313, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 21.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 11.2 acres was changed by order of the State Engineer entered August 22, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to C. C. Babcock.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
