CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROBERT B. ECKFORD

of Sunny Valley , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of School House Gulch

a tributary of Grave Creek irrigation of 3.1 acres, domestic use for one family

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 20818 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 18, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SE_{+}^{L}NE_{+}^{L}$, Section 12, T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{42}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.25 acres SW1 NE1 NW1 SE1 1.85 acres and Domestic Section 12
T. 34 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Robert B. Eckford and recorded at page 20361, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for domestic use and for the irrigation of 6.5 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion and the right to the use of water appurtenant to 3.4 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered August 22, 1969. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for domestic use and irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Robert B. Eckford.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
