CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That Mrs. MELISSA HARTELRODE
 of Paisley, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
 the waters of Chewaucan River, a tributary of Abert Lake
 for the purpose of the irrigation of 1 acre of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 1;
 that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1894

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth below; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: (3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year) Beginning at a point on the West line of Willow Street 40' West from a point on the East line of said street, said last point being 168½' South from the Northwest corner of Block A. Running thence westerly at right angles with said West line of Willow Street 153'; thence South at right angles with said last line and parallel to said West line of Willow Street 156½'; thence Easterly at right angles with said street 153' to the West line of Willow Street; thence Northerly along the West line of said Willow Street 168½' to place of beginning. All according to map and plat of the Town of Paisley, Oregon, filed with the County Clerk of Lake County, Oregon, December 14, 1879.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
