**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** DAVID M. & SARA K. WELCH, TRUMAN D. & Z. IDELLE COLLINS, JOHN J. & LOUELLA E. DICKENSON, & GEORGE P. & FLORENCE S. WALLER of Box 572, Tioga, State of North Dakota, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic, stock and irrigation of 18.0 acres

under Permit No. 12635 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1937

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.245 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic, 0.01 c.f.s. for stock and 0.225 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 15 for Welch, Collins and Dickenson, and Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 15 for Waller, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to David M. & Sara K. Welch, Truman D. & Z. Idelle Collins, John J. & Louella E. Dickenson, & George P. & Florence S. Waller, and recorded at page 31230, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 20.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 2.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered January 20, 1970. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to David M. & Sara K. Welch, Truman D. & Z. Idelle Collins, John J. & Louella E. Dickenson, & George P. & Florence S. Waller.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
