## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN H. and BONNIE JEAN McGUFFEY

of Route 2, Box 56, Bend , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Deschutes River

a tributary of Columbia River

for the purpose of

domestic use of one family and irrigation of 3.0 acres

under Permit No. 27095 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

August 10, 1960 for 0.04 c.f.s.

September 13, 1960 for 0.05 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.08 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL NWL, Section 20, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W. M. Diversion point located 380 feet South and 720 feet West from NE Corner, SEL NWL,

Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; The right allowed herein is subject to the following limitations:\*

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and J.O acres SEL NWL Section 20 T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W. M.

\*1. The permittee shall make no diversion of water when the flow of Deschutes River at the point of diversion described in his application is less than 50 c.f.s. 2. The permittee shall install, operate and maintain at his own expense an electronic control device in accordance with plans and specifications to be prepared by him and approved by the State Engineer, such device to be capable of shutting down the pumping plant whenever the flow of Deschutes River immediately downstream from the diversion point is less than 50 c.f.s.

3. The rights of the permittee to divert water for this project shall be subordinate to any future storage and/or appropriations of water made under authority of the withdrawal by the State Engineer dated February 28, 1913 of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
