## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONNA E. GILL

of Route 2, Box 1385, Bend , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Weber Springs, unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-37114, Permit No. R-2684

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of

supplemental irrigation of 10.0 acres and stock use

under Permit No. 27588 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 12, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second; being 0.07 c.f.s. from Weber Spring, 0.18 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for irrigation, 0.01 c.f.s. from weber Spring, 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and reservoir for stock use.

unnamed stream and reservoir for stock use,
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW/A NW/4, Section 2; NW/4 SE/4, Section 3; T. 17 S.,
R. 11 E., W. M. Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock and 10.0 acres SW1/4 NW1/4

Section 2 T. 17 S., R. 11 E., W. M.

Diversion points located: Reservoir and Stream - 300 feet North and 550 feet East; Weber Springs - 210 feet South and 1330 feet West; both from W/4 Corner, Section 2.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
