## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOE HEESACKER

of Route 1, Box 295, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-41450, Permit No. R-4669

a trioutary of Dairy Creek supplemental irrigation of 28.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30964 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 17, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL SWL, Section 14, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 280 feet East and 50 feet South from NW Corner, NEL SWL, Section 14.

Section 1½.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one-cubic feet per-second per-acres a diversion of 4.0 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

19.5 acres NEL SWE 9.0 acres SEL SWE Section 14 T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
