## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 S. W. Alder Street, Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Trout Creek

a tributary of Eagle Creek (Powder River Watershed) for the purpose of fish propagation and maintenance of Pondosa Pond as a public fishing area

under Permit No. 9866 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 15, 1930

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEM SEM, Section 25, T. 5 S., R. 42 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SEW SWW4 Section 25 T. 6 S., R. 41 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in type of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 5, 1963, and together with the certificate recorded at page 36583, Volume 28, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to P. J. Powers, J. R. Wanker and Pondosa Water Company and recorded at page 10747, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
