CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JACK and MARGARET CRAMER

of Route 2, Box 57-B, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Beaver Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 6 acres, domestic and stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1881;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 40 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located: 1170 feet North and 430 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 5. A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 4.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 0.2 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 5
 T. 40 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate supersedes the certificate recorded at page 16442, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, issued to C. C. Buck, and describes the right as corrected by decrees and orders of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, entered February 4, 1970 and February 26, 1970.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
