## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That OREGON STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 S. W. Alder Street, Portland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Big Creek

a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of fish propagation and maintenance of Pondosa Pond as a public fishing area and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fourth of a cubic foot per second;

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T. 6 S., R. 41 E., W. M. Diversion point located below:  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 25  
T. 6 S., R. 41 E., W. M.

Diversion point located: 1560 feet South and 530 feet West from the NE Corner, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in type of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered June 5, 1963, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Grande Ronde Lumber Company and recorded at page 7388, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
